Trail Information

Orillia's Lightfoot Trail System is well used and growing. It is part of a regional trail system. Eventually it will loop through the City, running through parks, along the City's many waterfronts, into neighbourhoods and link with adjacent Municipal trails. The existing development of the City's trail system is shown below. In the future, the system will incorporate various named sections, including the existing, paved, shared -use Millennium Trail. Here are the current aspects of the trail system.

Trail distances:

- Existing system including linked park trails - 33 km
 - Millennium Trail running adjacent to Lake Couchiching shoreline - 8 km
 - Gravel trail running north/south - 9 km
- Surface: Paved, gravel (connecting with natural trails in some parks)

Grade: Flat w/ a few moderate inclines (Note: Trails in Scout Valley have some steep inclines)

Connections to Municipal Trails

- The Uthhoff Trail to the north
- The Oro-Medonte Rail Trail to the south
- The Ramara Trail to the east

Sections of the Trans Canada and Ganaraska Hiking Trails traverse through Orillia's Lightfoot Trail System as well.
